Friday 18.09

Chek in at 0700 at Atlantic Airways desk in Terminal 2

Departure Copenhagen 0830 – arr. Vagar Airport in the Faroe Islands at 1015 local time (1 hours difference).

A guide will pick you up at the airport and take you around for a full day excursion.

The tour goes to Vestmanna (northern part of Streymoy) where you'll visit the new open viking museum. www.visit-vestmanna.com. and you'll see the sightseeing boats, which go to the Vestmanna bird cliffs during summertime.

Then you head north and cross the bridge to Eysturoy to the village Eiði with a spectacular view of Slættaratindur (882m), the highest mountain in the Faroe Islands. Then you drive to Gjógv a tiny village, which is known for its distinctive natural harbour and for the nice and cosy guesthouse Gjáargarður. www.gjaargardur.fo

On the way to Tórshavn, you'll stop at Gøta to see the new church with its fantastic glass art decoration.

Chek in Hotel Hafnia for overnight.

Saturday 19.09

Ferry from Tórshavn dept 0700 – arr. Suduroy 0900

Fullday tour Suduroy (southern island)

The day starts onboard the ferry Smyril, which takes you to Suðuroy, you can see the islands Sandoy, Stóra Dímun and Lítla Dímun on the trip.

When you enter the fjord of Tvøroyri, you'll see the spectacular nature. We take you around the island, where you can see coalmines, churches, museums, galleries, special phenomenon in the nature, like unusual formations of columnar basalt.

Together with us you'll experience all this and possibly even more. We enjoy a good meal and get a lot of fresh clean air and experience the marvellous nature.

Last stop at idyllic village Bøur and the old warehouse from 1861 where lunch (Faroese buffet) will be served and a short island-presentation before the bus takes you back to the airport.
